Sub. Action taken report (March to July, 2020) on Sensitization Campaign on Dengue & other vector-borne diseases and COVID-19 within College campus and Baker Govt. Hostel, Maulana Azad College, Kolkata.

Madam,

Propos your letter No. ED-113/2020 dated 3rd July, 2020, I am to state that the following measures have been taken by the College in preventing Dengue and other vector-borne diseases and COVID-19:

1. College constituted a fourteen-member Sanitization Supervision Committee on 27th May, 2020, besides earlier six members 'Prevention of Vector-borne diseases committee' to visit and survey and to suggest necessary measures on Dengue, other Vector-borne diseases and COVID-19.
2. Recently Sanitization Supervision and Prevention of Vector-borne diseases committees have conducted virtual meeting on Google Meet with NSS and Students Support Cell (Kanyashree) volunteers for creating sensitization campaign among students and staffs while they are at home, and are provided with necessary guidelines about how to prevent and take precautionary measures against Dengue and other vector-borne diseases amidst COVID-19 pandemic situation (image enclosed).
3. After the virtual meeting, Committees are in the process of sending detailed advisory to incorporate the students and faculties and staff in combating the Dengue and other vector-borne diseases following COVID-19 norms to the respective Departmental Heads for onward transmission of such programme to students through Departmental WhatsApp Group.
4. 41 students from six Departments under guidance of four teachers surveyed and documented flora, fauna, bioresources and Dengue and other vector-borne diseases first-hand information from KMC 52-Ward near Maulana Azad College, for the purpose of preparation of First PBR (Peoples' Biodiversity Register') in Kolkata Municipal Corporation in collaboration with West Bengal Biodiversity Board, Kolkata (Report & image attached). Report also submitted to KMC in March, 2020.
5. A detailed survey has been carried out in the 2nd week of March by Students Support Cell (Kanyashree Volunteers) (report as enclosed).
6. Kolkata Municipal Corporation trained staffs are regularly spraying larvicidal inside College Campus and Baker Government Hostel on every Tuesday.
7. Trained college cleaning staffs are regularly cleaning inside College Premise.
8. Kolkata Municipal Corporation Staffs are regularly cleaning outside College Premise and drain blockage inside and outside college premise.
9. Fire Brigade Departmental trained staffs sanitized inside College premise including Departments and Laboratories in June 2020 (report and image enclosed)

Plan for sanitizing the college premises including the class rooms, laboratories, computer centers, office, library, student section and other accessible / public areas of Maulana Azad College:

- The Campus and outer premises are entrusted to KMC, WB Fire service, PWD, Contractual House Keeping Personnel and Regular College Cleaning Staff.
- Before opening of the institution thorough cleaning and sanitization to be done by college cleaning staff members under the guidance of the college supervising committee in the following manner:
 - i. Overall dusting and sweeping of all the accessible areas.
 - ii. Spray a water solution of detergent and disinfectant (Dettol / Lysol etc.) over furniture, floor, door, door knobs, and railing etc.
 - iii. Laboratories to be cleaned with the same process except the instruments and computers.
 - iv. Departmental staff be present during sanitization.
 - v. For instruments and computers alcohol-based sanitizers or specific sanitizers to be used.
- All the cleaning staff to use hand gloves and face mask during the cleaning process.
- Office and staff room be cleaned before 10 a.m.
- All the class rooms, library, student section, corridors, laboratories to be cleaned daily after completion of the classes.
- Wash Rooms to be cleaned twice daily, morning and noon time suitably.
- Social distancing and personal hygiene be maintained with utmost care.

During 1st phase Lockdown period (21st March, 2020 to 7th June, 2020), College was closed, gates were locked except in emergency cases. During this period, 'Prevention of Vector-borne disease subcommittee' monitored the work and after 27th May, 2020, both 'Sanitization Supervision Committee' and 'Prevention of Vector-borne disease subcommittee' regularly monitor following activities:-

1. 'Prevention of Vector-borne Diseases' and 'Sanitization Supervision subcommittees' regularly monitor and conduct virtual meeting among teaching and non-teaching staffs for creating awareness among staffs for prevention of Dengue and other vector-borne diseases and COVID-19.
2. 'Prevention of Vector-borne Diseases' and 'Sanitization Supervision subcommittee' conducted one virtual meeting with NSS and Students Support Cell (Kanyasree) volunteers for creating awareness for prevention of Dengue and Other Vector-borne diseases and COVID-19.
3. After the virtual meeting, Committees are in the process of sending detailed advisory to incorporate the students and faculties and staff in combating the Dengue and other vector-borne diseases following COVID-19 norms to the respective Departmental Heads for online transmission of such programme to students through Departmental Whatsapp Group.
4. These Committees are engaging NSS and Kanyasree volunteers in several Groups to send message to students for creating awareness for prevention of Dengue and Other Vector-borne diseases and COVID-19, while they are at their home.
5. Committees are also trying to send message directly to the students to encourage them to keep their household environment clean to prevent the growth of larvae of Dengue and other vector-borne diseases, as well as instructing them to wear N95/three-layered Surgical Masks, regular interval hand washing and sanitization if and when they go outside.
6. Cleaning Staffs are maintaining their cleaning inside the College Premise including Veranda, front & Back Sides, maintaining Social distance, wearing N-97 Face Mask and using self-prepared Alcoholic Sanitizer by the College.

7. Emergency services attained by the security at Front Gate like Kolkata Municipal Corporation Lervicidal Spray to control vector-borne diseases including Dengue every Tuesday. In that case, Specially trained KMC Technicians are thermal screened by our Security.
8. Baker Government Hostel was closed since 21st March, 2020, but regular cleaning by the College Cleaning Staffs and Lavicidal spray by specially trained KMC technicians are done.
9. Locality Survey by Maulana Azad College Kanyasree students in March, 2020.
10. Forty one students under 6 Departments under guidance of 4 teachers surveyed and documented flora, fauna, bioresources and dengue and other vector borne diseases first hand information data for the purpose of preparation of PBR (Peoples' Biodiversity Register) first time in Kolkata Municipal Corporation in February-March, 2020. Report also submitted to KMC in March, 2020.

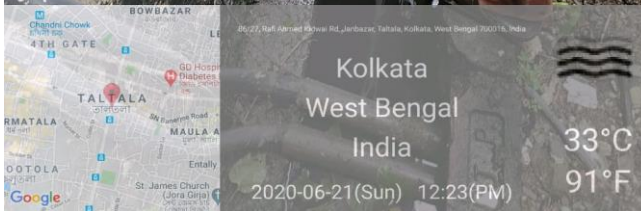
