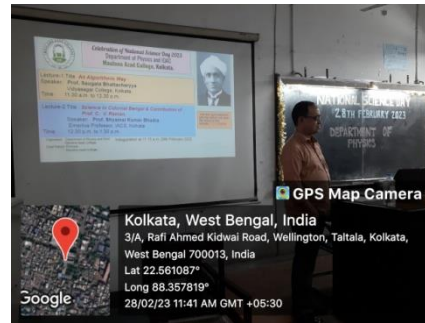
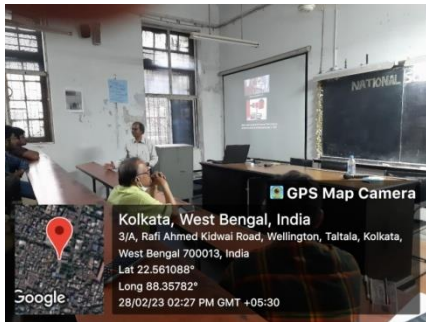
The followings are the summary of the salient activities in the department during the period June, 2022 – May, 2023:

- **Departmental Meetings and their summary resolutions:**

1. 1. Date: 05-07-2022; Agenda: Internal Marks consideration of the Semester-6 students; Resolutions: Marks in each paper are considered and decided.
2. 2. Date: 28-07-2022; Agenda: Internal Marks consideration of the Semester-2 & Semester – 4 students; Resolutions: Marks in each paper are considered and decided.
3. 3. Date: 09-09-2022 ; Agenda: Document verification for newly admitted students, Consideration of the suggestions given during Academic Audit 2020 & Matters arising; Resolutions: Norms for the document verification has been decided. A leave register is decided to be kept in the department. Different faculty members are allotted some specific responsibilities like arranging seminars, adding fresh books to the dept. seminar library etc. Some discussions were also held regarding formation of dept. Alumni Association & purchasing some necessary equipment for the laboratories.
