

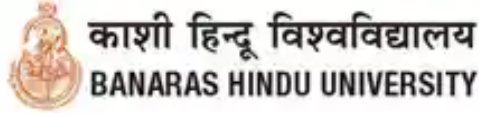

## ANNEXURE I

### Terms and conditions of admission to PhD and I-PhD for Research Scholars

All academic procedures shall be the same for all Research Scholars (Resident Scholars and Day-Scholars). Research Scholars are required to abide by the Deemed University Rules and Procedures, as well as the Rules and Byelaws of TIFR.

#### **A. Appointment, stipend, contingency**

1) Stipend and Contingency: Resident/ Day-Scholars **admitted to the PhD programme** will initially receive a fixed monthly fellowship of Rs 31000/- (which will be raised to Rs 35000/- after registration for Ph.D.) and an annual contingency grant of Rs 40000/-. Resident / Day-Scholars **admitted to the I-PhD programme** will initially receive a fixed monthly fellowship of Rs 21000/- and a book grant of Rs 25000/- for the first year. At the end of the first year, upon satisfactory performance, the fellowship will be enhanced to Rs 31000/- per month (and further to Rs 35000/- after registration for PhD) and an annual contingency grant of Rs 40000/- will be available. The contingency and book grants can be utilized towards purchase of books, laptops/computer peripherals, stationery, the details of which can be found at [https://www.tifr.res.in/~qsoffice/contingency\\_grant.htm](https://www.tifr.res.in/~qsoffice/contingency_grant.htm)

2) Duration of appointment: Resident/ Day-Scholar appointments will be renewed from August 1st each year, subject to satisfactory performance, for a maximum period of 5 years (PhD) / 6 years (I-PhD), termed as the 'regular term'. In exceptional situations, extension beyond the regular term may be considered.

3) All Resident/ Day-Scholars are required to complete the course requirements of their graduate programme to the satisfaction of the relevant Subject Board. They may take leave only with the concurrence of the Subject Board and the Dean of their School.

4) The Institute reserves the right to terminate a Resident/ Day-Scholar's appointment, if it becomes necessary, by giving 30 days' notice. Likewise, Scholars wishing to resign are obliged to give 30 days' notice to the Institute.

#### **B. Housing**

Resident scholars are normally given on-campus housing up to the end of July of their 5th (PhD) or 6th (I-PhD) year. Resident scholars have the option of not taking accommodation for any period of 6 months or longer, and instead claiming a house rent allowance (HRA, 24% of the stipend amount) in lieu of housing. For all students claiming HRA, a self-declaration that they are not staying as a guest in TIFR housing will be required.

Day-Scholars: Students admitted to the Day-Scholar programme are not eligible for housing for the entire duration of their term. They will get a house rent allowance @ 24% of the stipend amount in lieu of housing. For all students claiming HRA, a self-declaration that they are not staying as a guest in TIFR housing will be required.

TIFR does not have any association with these agents or agencies and you are requested to verify the information and use it as you see fit. ## C. Payment of deposit:

Resident Scholars: All Resident Scholars are required to pay an amount of Rs 10,000/- deposit towards a refundable hostel and canteen deposit by online bank transfer (NEFT/RTGS) by the acceptance deadline in the offer letter.

The deposit amount will not be refunded if you fail to join TIFR. The deposit amount will be refunded together with your last month's pay when you leave TIFR, subject to clearing the no-dues procedures.

Day- Scholars: All Day- Scholars are required to pay an amount of Rs 5,000/- deposit towards a refundable canteen deposit by bringing a DD with them when they arrive at TIFR. It should be submitted together with their joining documents. Please do not make this payment by NEFT/RTGS.

## D. Medical information

1) Before joining: Admission of a Resident / Day-Scholar is subject to satisfactory medical examination by the Institute's Medical Officer. It is mandatory to take the following vaccines before joining the Institute. You are required to submit the vaccination certificates specified below (duly signed by a registered medical practitioner) to the Institute Medical Section at the time of completing the medical fitness formalities:

- a) MMR vaccine -2 doses
- b) Chickenpox vaccine - 2 dose

If a Resident / Day-Scholar has had a confirmed case of Chickenpox, then he/she will not be required to take the Chickenpox vaccination. The following vaccines are recommended (but not mandatory) for the overall well-being/welfare of the student:

- i) Tdap-1 dose,
- ii) Hepatitis B- 3 doses,
- iii) Typhoid- 1 dose every 3 years.

2) Medical benefits: A Resident / Day-Scholar is not a regular employee of the Institute and is not entitled to those benefits that pertain to regular employees. However, specific benefits (including certain medical benefits) are extended to all Scholars.

## E. Academic Calendar and joining dates:

**This year is unusual due to the COVID-19 pandemic. GS-2020 students will physically join after they arrive here in person in the first week of January 2021. However, to ensure that you do not lose precious months, the academic calendar and classes will begin in online mode on September 2nd 2020.**

1) Academic activities: The schedule of the initial week is below. All Resident scholars and Day-Scholars who have accepted admission by the acceptance deadline will receive direct communication from their respective departments/course coordinators about the details and schedule of the online sessions.

**2) Joining information:**

Arrival dates for Resident Scholars and Day scholars are given below. These dates are subject to revision based on the evolving situation with COVID-19. Detailed joining instructions including what to do immediately upon arrival at TIFR will be sent approximately a month before the joining date.

Tuesday Jan 5th: I-PhD (men) resident scholars

Thursday Jan 7th: PhD (men) and all women (I-PhD and PhD) resident scholars

Friday Jan 8th: All Day-Scholars (PhD, I-PhD, MSc) men and women

You are required to arrive between 08:00 - 15:00 on your specific arrival date. No special arrangements can be made outside these hours.

1) Please bring three color photographs (size 3.5 cm x 4.5 cm) at the time of joining.

2) Please also bring with you all your original certificates (along with one set of copies) at the time of joining for verification. If your final examination results have not yet been declared, you will be admitted on a provisional basis, subject to your passing the relevant degree examination. The admission will be regularized when you produce your degree certificate.

3) Please bring your vaccination certificates described under "Medical information" above, and any other relevant medical certificates pertaining to your individual medical history.

## **Addendum to Annexure I for GS2020**

**This year is unusual due to the COVID-19 pandemic. GS-2020 students will physically join the institute after they arrive here in person in the first week of January 2021. However, to ensure that you do not lose precious months, the academic calendar and classes will begin in online mode on September 2nd 2020. The following addendum to Annexure I explains some of the changes caused due to this difference in dates between the “physical joining” and “admission to the academic programme”**

**Admission to the academic programme:** The academic programme will begin in Sept/Oct 2020 as informed to each student by their respective TIFR Center. Allows the student to start attending online classes and begin academic activity. No requirements of mark sheets and other documents is required at the beginning of this period. However, all students are expected to submit the signed acceptance form (Annexure II at the end of this document).

**Physical joining as a Research Scholar:** The physical joining at TIFR allows the student to get a stipend and a hostel room (for resident scholars), and tuition fees as applicable. All the requirements in Annexure I (including passing their last degree exam and passing the medical examination of TIFR etc) are to be fulfilled prior to the physical joining.

**Renewal of Academic appointment versus Research Scholar appointment:** For GS-2020 students, renewal of BOTH these will occur on August 1<sup>st</sup> in 2021 and each year thereafter for the entire duration of the regular term, subject to satisfactory performance. This means that GS-2020 students will begin their 2<sup>nd</sup> year on August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021. I-PhD stipends and contingencies, however, will increase to the PhD levels one year from the date of joining physically (Research Scholar appointment).

PhD students of the GS-2020 batch who complete 5 academic years (July 31<sup>st</sup> 2025) and I-PhD students of the GS-2020 batch who complete 6 academic years (July 31<sup>st</sup> 2026), provided their academic term is extended, will be entitled to an additional few months of stipend+contingency as Research Scholars corresponding to the shortfall in the number of months of stipend in their 1<sup>st</sup> academic year, thus, in principle, allowing them a full 5 (PhD) or 6 (I-PhD) years of stipend as Research Scholars.

**Contingency/ Book Grant funds:** GS-2020 students can purchase items from the approved list below any time after August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020. The reimbursement will be made against their contingency/book grant after they physically join TIFR and their names are entered in the system as TIFR Research Scholars (Resident/Day-Scholars). This is a special arrangement due to the COVID-19 situation, so that students may purchase learning materials such as laptops or peripherals or pay internet bills associated with the online academic session, prior to their physical joining at TIFR as Research Scholars.

**Amount of Contingency/Book Grant:** Rs. 40,000 (PhD students) and Rs 25,000 (I-PhD students) in their 1<sup>st</sup> year as Research Scholars. If the student leaves TIFR before the completion of the year, the amount of the grant the student is eligible for will be prorated (proportional to the fraction of the year spent in the Institute as a Research Scholar) and any extra amount reimbursed will be recovered.

Contingency/Book Grant funds expire on July 31<sup>st</sup> each year and will be pro-rated according to the number of months spent as a Research Scholar until this date each year. For example, for GS-2020 students who join in January 2021, their 1<sup>st</sup> academic year's contingency/book grant will be prorated at 7/12<sup>th</sup> the total yearly amount corresponding to 7 months as Research Scholars from January- July 2021. For I-PhD scholars, the “book grant” of Rs. 25,000 applies for 12 months after physically joining as a research scholar, and after that a “contingency grant” of Rs. 40000 applies for each year. The amounts will be pro-rated accordingly. The grant will continue for the regular term of the Research Scholar appointment, 5 years (PhD) and 6 years (I-PhD).

**Permissible expenses:** are listed below. Note that in the 1<sup>st</sup> year, PhD students get a “contingency grant” for which items 1-6 are permissible, while I-PhD students get a “book grant” for which items 1, 4, 5 and 6 are permissible. These funds are to be used for academic purposes. You may be asked to justify any claim prior to reimbursement. For example, the internet bills should be commensurate with the academic demands.

1. Purchase of academic books, journals, photocopying
2. Payment of fellowships/memberships of professional organizations/societies
3. Travel to conferences, workshop and other educational trips
4. Purchase of Laptops, Notebook, Tablet PCs, e-book reader etc.
5. Purchase of computer peripherals, accessories and software (note these must be related to your studies and not more than Rs. 4000)
6. Internet Bills for students not in the TIFR campus (note that these need to be within reason and commensurate with the online academic load)

**Spillovers:** If the cost of a particular item is more than the available amount of the Contingency Grant/ Book Grant, the extra amount may be claimed from the next year's Contingency Grant once the student becomes eligible for it. Expensive items e.g. laptops may be reimbursed in parts over multiple years.

**Important:** Please note that a valid Invoice (with Invoice number, CST/GST/VAT numbers) is required and not simply a Delivery Challan or Proforma Invoice. This must be in the name of the student claiming the reimbursement. We cannot reimburse expenses in the name of a parent or any person other than the student.
